Re: Proposed Ordinance Amendment Concerning Farmers'

Markets (15228)

GENERAL INFORMATION

This is a request of staff from the Board of Commissioners to prepare and process ordinance amendments regarding farmers' markets. This request is in line with the Unified Government's initiative to improve health across the County through Healthy Communities Wyandotte. Community stakeholders have identified the current special use permit process for farmers' markets as a barrier to the access to local, healthy food.

This report outlines the following proposed ordinance amendments:

- Provide a definition for farmers' markets
- Amend the allowable special uses to include farmers' markets
- Amend the accessory uses section of the code to allow farmers' markets in the following districts and their planned equivalent counterparts: AG, C-0, C-1, C-D, C-2, C-3, M-1, M-2, M-3, and TND

In conjunction with the above ordinance amendments, it is staff's recommendation to also adjust special use permit application requirements for farmers' markets outside of the above mentioned zoning districts. An additional category for "farmers' markets" under miscellaneous special use permits with a fee of \$75.00 would supplement the stated purpose.

PROPOSAL

Staff proposes the following ordinance modifications to achieve the goals of the community:

Sec. 27-340. – Definitions.

Farmers' Market, means any common facility or area where fruits, vegetables, meats, other local farm or consumable products, etc., are sold directly to consumers by producers, growers, and sellers at more than one (1) stand operated by different persons.

<u>Local Produce</u>, means produce grown within 100 miles of the Kansas City, Kansas corporate limit.

Sec. 27-593. - Allowable special uses.

- (a) The following uses may be permitted under special use permit in any zoning district except as specifically limited herein:
 - (31) Farmers' markets in the R through C-0 districts.
 - a. <u>Farmers' markets are allowed in A-G and C-1 through M-3 districts upon submitting an annual agreement with the Department of Urban Planning and Land Use in these districts.</u>

Sec. 27-608. - District AG.

In the AG district, accessory uses are as follows:

- (4) Farmers' markets
 - a. Farmers' markets are allowed upon submitting an annual agreement with the Department of Urban Planning and Land Use in this district. Farmers' markets that take place outside of the following zoning districts require a special use permit.

Sec. 27-611. - District C-0.

- (a) In the C-0 district, accessory uses are as follows:
 - (10) Farmers' markets

a. <u>Farmers' markets are allowed upon submitting an annual agreement with the Department of Urban Planning and Land Use in these districts. Farmers' markets that take place outside of the following zoning districts require a special use permit.</u>

Sec. 27-612. - Districts C-1, C-D, C-2 and C-3.

In the C-1, C-D, C-2, and C-3 districts, accessory uses are as follows:

(8) Farmers' markets

a. Farmers' markets are allowed upon submitting an annual agreement with the Department of Urban Planning and Land Use in these districts. Farmers' markets that take place outside of the following zoning districts require a special use permit.

Sec. 27-613. - Districts M-1; M-2 and M-3.

In the M-1, M-2 and M-3 districts, accessory uses are as follows:

(9) Farmers' markets

a. Farmers' markets are allowed upon submitting an annual agreement with the Department of Urban Planning and Land Use in these districts. Farmers' markets that take place outside of the following zoning districts require a special use permit.

Sec. 27-614. - District TND.

In the TND district, accessory uses are as follows:

(1) Those accessory uses permitted in district AG through districts C-1, C-D, C-2, and C-3 districts.

(2) Farmers' markets

a. Farmers' markets are allowed upon submitting an annual agreement with the Department of Urban Planning and Land Use in this district. Farmers' markets that take place outside of the following zoning districts require a special use permit.

In no case shall any sign be placed within a regulatory sight triangle, twenty-five (25) feet of the edge of pavement, or any clear zone, as defined by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials.
